It eliminates the risk of injury to tenants, which in turn reduces your liability exposure. Protecting Your Walls from DIY Disasters

If you don't provide a wall-mounted solution, tenants will often try to install one themselves. Without the correct tools or knowledge of Irish construction methods (like dot-and-dab walls), they often use incorrect fixings. When they eventually move out, you are left with a wall that looks like Swiss cheese, requiring expensive skimming and repainting.

By taking control and installing the bracket professionally at the start of the tenancy, you dictate the terms. You ensure the bracket is level, secure, and placed in a sensible location. Even if the tenant brings their own TV, having a universal bracket already on the wall prevents them from drilling fresh holes. It preserves the condition of your walls for years, spanning multiple tenancies.

Theft Deterrence and Security

In short-term lets or student accommodation, security of contents is a genuine concern. A TV sitting on a cabinet can be walked out the front door in seconds. A wall-mounted TV, particularly one secured with anti-theft locking screws, is a much more difficult target.

Commercial-grade mounts can be padlocked or require specialised tools to remove the screen. This acts as a strong deterrent against opportunistic theft. For the landlord, it provides peace of mind knowing that the inventory is physically secured to the property. It's a small investment in hardware that secures a much larger investment in electronics.

Cable Management and Mould Prevention

A hidden benefit of wall mounting is airflow. Televisions generate heat, and if pushed back against a wall on a cabinet, or surrounded by clutter, that heat can cause condensation issues on external walls—a common problem in older Irish rental stock.

Professional installation ensures the TV is spaced correctly from the wall, promoting airflow. Furthermore, by trunking cables neatly, you prevent the build-up of dust bunnies and "cable nests" that are difficult to clean. It encourages the tenant to keep the area tidy. A clean, mould-free property is easier to inspect and easier to rent out again when the time comes.
